ADVOCATE

We are committed to secure funding that fits the needs of our members - and we get results. That's because lawmakers know our advocacy demands represent the needs of more than 280+ organizations that span the entire state of Arizona.



Arizona Housing Coalition spearheaded the call for increasing the State Housing Trust Fund, and the Legislature allocated **\$60 million** to the fund to address growing housing challenges Arizona families face



The Arizona Housing Coalition was appointed to **statewide** Legislative housing supply committee

\$160M

Advocated for the state low-income housing tax credit, which was signed into law on July 9, 2021, by Governor Ducey, providing a \$4 million, 10 year credit allocation for 4 years, **representing a \$160 million total investment**



Coalition Executive Director named as one of **Arizona Capitol Times' Power 12 Leaders** in the housing industry



Consulted on **18 proposed** municipal housing policies, including housing plans, zoning and land use proposals; Engaged with workgroups across the **3 Arizona Continuums of Care** on equity within our homeless response systems

COORDINATE

We work to provide thousands of people in need with vital services, made possible by our community, collaboration and coordination. Working with us means increased opportunities and making invaluable connections



Hosted the Maricopa County StandDown which served **700 veterans**, and coordinated StandDown events across the state, helping **1,635 Veterans** in need



Collaborated with ASU Knowledge Exchange for Resilience and New America on their **Foreclosure and Eviction Analysis Tool**, helping to improve eviction data statewide



Created the **Heroes Pathway to Hope pilot program** in collaboration with the AZDVS and BeConnected, providing funding for veterans requiring a higher level of care, with the long-term goal of advocating for ongoing fund sources to meet this critical gap
