Please share a brief story about a veteran that attended the event and had a positive outcome

A homeless veteran registering with an experienced intake person was persuaded to take the HEP-C and HIV panel testing. This was a first time resource and was in place because the VA could not get samples to the VAMC Prescott testing site in time. After testing it was determined that he probably had HEP-C and he was promptly scheduled for treatment on Monday March 5th, just two days after the Stand Down ended. Two additional veterans were also determined to have HEP-C and treatment was scheduled for the week of March 5th. The testing provider was the Lions Club of Bullhead City and Kingman and this was their first year participating in a Stand Down. They had been persuaded to provide this resource as a result of a talk given at a lunch meeting months before. The testing found 52 other veterans did not have HEP-C or HIV and they are glad to know the result. This testing reached an audience that would never have been tested had it not been for the Stand Down and the resources provided. This was easily the highlight for me.
