

Call to Storytellers – My Lens

The Arizona Housing Coalition is seeking front line workers (anyone working directly with people experiencing homelessness or recently housed) to create a short video addressing two questions:

1. What is your role in helping to get people housed?
2. In your experience, what is one thing we could change to improve results?

What's in it for you?

You get to help educate the public about the role of front line employees, and share your ideas for improving the system.

Storytellers selected to record their stories will receive a \$100 gift card. In addition, three storytellers will be invited to record and air their stories on Social Television Network (STN) and at our 28th Annual Conference on February 28 and March 1, 2023. Each story will result in a 2-minute video that highlights the critical role you play in helping to address homelessness.

Enthusiasm for project
Ability to communicate ideas
Diversity of storytellers (geography, role, race/ethnicity, age, etc.)
